As 2018 comes to an end, we thank God for His faithfulness that the ministry has continued to grow this year. We are finishing a dormitory expansion project by adding 18 additional bed spaces here on our campus to increase our total capacity to 101 beds. Our current enrollment will reach 97 total students when our new incoming class arrives on Dec. 27th, 2018. This year we graduated 62 students who are now serving ministries from Hawaii to New York! We are incredibly grateful to all of you who support the Teen Challenge Ministry Institute through your prayers and your financial contributions. Your partnership is helping us prevent many who are at risk from going down the wrong road, and help others break the chains of sin and addiction!

Teen Challenge of Southern California hosted the Arise Crusade at the Big Fresno Fair recently and there were about 4,500 in attendance. International evangelist Nick Vujicic, President of Life without Limbs Ministries, preached about the gospel of Jesus Christ. One hundred and thirty eight people responded to an invitation to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior! TCMI students participated as the decision follow up workers to provide Bibles and referrals to local churches to be disciple and have continued fellowship with other believers.

This year 6 missionaries from TCMI were sent on assignments to Romania, Poland, Brazil and the Phillipines.
